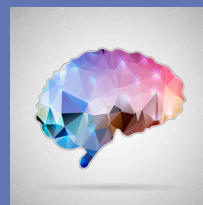

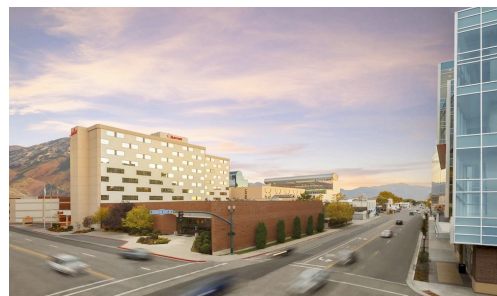
Marriott Provo Conference Center & Utah Valley Conference Center
