BYRON ADAMS



Dr. Adams is a professor and the Coordinator of Graduate Programs in the Department of Biology at Brigham Young University. For the past few years, he and members of the Nematode Evolution Lab have traveled to Antarctica to collect samples of invertebrate life, including nematodes, tardigrades, and rotifers. Using morphometric and genetic data, Dr. Adams' team has described the trophic, phylogenetic and phylogeographic relationships among these critical members of Antarctic soil life.
